Dear Parents,

The well-being and success of our students are top priorities of Anson Independent School District. This commitment includes ensuring your child can access nutritious food at school and other points in our community.

Starting on November 2, 2020, Anson Independent School District is operating the Seamless Summer Option. This federal nutrition program allows us to serve nutritious meals in our community to children 18 and younger and enrolled students with disabilities up to 21 years old at no cost to your family. All Anson Independent School District students can receive daily meals at no cost. We are pleased to be able to offer these meals at no cost to our students and children in the community from November 2, 2020 through June 30, 2021.

Breakfast and lunch will be available to our community children not enrolled in school (under school age) for pick-up from 8:00 - 8:30 at Anson High School. Children must be with the parents when meals are picked up. Meals for Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday are available on Monday; meals for Thursday and Friday are available on Thursday.

In addition to school meals, you and your family may be able to access food through community organizations operating programs such as the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC). These programs can provide additional support during the COVID-19 public health emergency.
